## Frank Aguilar – 228<sup>th</sup> District Court

Detained:

- **83% of Black defendants (90 out of 108)**
- **64% of Hispanic White defendants (28 out of 44)**
- **49% of non-Hispanic White defendants (40 out of 81)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Frank Aguilar** detained **83% of Black defendants (90 out of 108 on an average night)**, **64% of Hispanic White defendants (28 out of 44 on an average night)**, and **49% of non-Hispanic White defendants (40 out of 81 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Aguilar's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County. His **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County.
