## Frank Aguilar – 228<sup>th</sup> District Court

Detained:

- **84% of Black defendants (92 out of 110)**
- **64% of Hispanic White defendants (28 out of 44)**
- **50% of non-Hispanic White defendants (41 out of 82)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Frank Aguilar** detained **84% of Black defendants (92 out of 110 on an average night)**, **64% of Hispanic White defendants (28 out of 44 on an average night)**, and **50% of non-Hispanic White defendants (41 out of 82 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Aguilar's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County. His **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% worst** in Harris County.
