Frank Aguilar – 228th District Court

Detained:

- **80% of Black defendants (89 out of 111)**
- **55% of Hispanic White defendants (24 out of 43)**
- **48% of non-Hispanic White defendants (43 out of 89)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Frank Aguilar** detained **80% of Black defendants (89 out of 111 on an average night)**, **55% of Hispanic White defendants (24 out of 43 on an average night)**, and **48% of non-Hispanic White defendants (43 out of 89 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Aguilar's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County. His **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% best** in Harris County.
