## Frank Aguilar – 228<sup>th</sup> District Court

Detained:

- **78% of Black defendants (89 out of 114)**
- **57% of Hispanic White defendants (26 out of 45)**
- **50% of non-Hispanic White defendants (48 out of 97)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, Judge Frank Aguilar detained 78% of Black defendants (89 out of 114 on an average night), 57% of Hispanic White defendants (26 out of 45 on an average night), and 50% of non-Hispanic White defendants (48 out of 97 on an average night) in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Aguilar's racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants is among the 25% worst in Harris County. His racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants is among the 50% best in Harris County.
