## Frank Aguilar – 228<sup>th</sup> District Court

Detained:

- **80% of Black defendants (95 out of 120)**
- **59% of Hispanic White defendants (28 out of 47)**
- **48% of non-Hispanic White defendants (45 out of 93)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Frank Aguilar** detained **80% of Black defendants (95 out of 120 on an average night)**, **59% of Hispanic White defendants (28 out of 47 on an average night)**, and **48% of non-Hispanic White defendants (45 out of 93 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Aguilar's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County. His **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% worst** in Harris County.
