Abigail Anastasio – 184th District Court

Detained:

- **80% of Black defendants (98 out of 122)**
- **68% of Hispanic White defendants (21 out of 31)**
- **53% of non-Hispanic White defendants (50 out of 94)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Abigail Anastasio** detained **80% of Black defendants (98 out of 122 on an average night)**, **68% of Hispanic White defendants (21 out of 31 on an average night)**, and **53% of non-Hispanic White defendants (50 out of 94 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Anastasio's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County. Her **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County.
