Abigail Anastasio – 184th District Court

Detained:

- **79% of Black defendants (93 out of 117)**
- **64% of Hispanic White defendants (23 out of 35)**
- **54% of non-Hispanic White defendants (50 out of 92)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Abigail Anastasio** detained **79% of Black defendants (93 out of 117 on an average night)**, **64% of Hispanic White defendants (23 out of 35 on an average night)**, and **54% of non-Hispanic White defendants (50 out of 92 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Anastasio's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County. Her **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% worst** in Harris County.
