Abigail Anastasio – 184th District Court

Detained:

- **80% of Black defendants (91 out of 114)**
- **65% of Hispanic White defendants (24 out of 37)**
- **54% of non-Hispanic White defendants (49 out of 91)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Abigail Anastasio** detained **80% of Black defendants (91 out of 114 on an average night)**, **65% of Hispanic White defendants (24 out of 37 on an average night)**, and **54% of non-Hispanic White defendants (49 out of 91 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Anastasio's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County. Her **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% worst** in Harris County.
