## Abigail Anastasio – 184<sup>th</sup> District Court

Detained:

- **80% of Black defendants (97 out of 121)**
- **72% of Hispanic White defendants (25 out of 35)**
- **50% of non-Hispanic White defendants (50 out of 100)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Abigail Anastasio** detained **80% of Black defendants (97 out of 121 on an average night)**, **72% of Hispanic White defendants (25 out of 35 on an average night)**, and **50% of non-Hispanic White defendants (50 out of 100 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Anastasio's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County. Her **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County.
