## Abigail Anastasio – 184<sup>th</sup> District Court

Detained:

- **79% of Black defendants (97 out of 122)**
- **73% of Hispanic White defendants (24 out of 33)**
- **49% of non-Hispanic White defendants (52 out of 105)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Abigail Anastasio** detained **79% of Black defendants (97 out of 122 on an average night)**, **73% of Hispanic White defendants (24 out of 33 on an average night)**, and **49% of non-Hispanic White defendants (52 out of 105 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Anastasio's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County. Her **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County.
