Lori Chambers Gray – 262nd District Court

Detained:

- **74% of Black defendants (109 out of 148)**
- **46% of Hispanic White defendants (23 out of 51)**
- **54% of non-Hispanic White defendants (62 out of 114)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Lori Chambers Gray** detained **74% of Black defendants (109 out of 148 on an average night)**, **46% of Hispanic White defendants (23 out of 51 on an average night)**, and **54% of non-Hispanic White defendants (62 out of 114 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Gray's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% worst** in Harris County. Her **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% best** in Harris County.
