## Lori Chambers Gray – 262<sup>nd</sup> District Court

Detained:

- **75% of Black defendants (112 out of 149)**
- **39% of Hispanic White defendants (19 out of 49)**
- **56% of non-Hispanic White defendants (66 out of 119)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, Judge Lori Chambers Gray detained 75% of Black defendants (112 out of 149 on an average night), 39% of Hispanic White defendants (19 out of 49 on an average night), and 56% of non-Hispanic White defendants (66 out of 119 on an average night) in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Gray's racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants is among the 50% best in Harris County. Her racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants is among the 25% worst in Harris County.
