## Ramona Franklin – 338<sup>th</sup> District Court

Detained:

- **82% of Black defendants (141 out of 172)**
- **63% of Hispanic White defendants (41 out of 65)**
- **62% of non-Hispanic White defendants (81 out of 131)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Ramona Franklin** detained **82% of Black defendants (141 out of 172 on an average night)**, **63% of Hispanic White defendants (41 out of 65 on an average night)**, and **62% of non-Hispanic White defendants (81 out of 131 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Franklin's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% worst** in Harris County. Her **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% best** in Harris County.
