Ramona Franklin – 338th District Court

Detained:

- **82% of Black defendants (138 out of 168)**
- **65% of Hispanic White defendants (44 out of 68)**
- **62% of non-Hispanic White defendants (85 out of 137)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Ramona Franklin** detained **82% of Black defendants (138 out of 168 on an average night)**, **65% of Hispanic White defendants (44 out of 68 on an average night)**, and **62% of non-Hispanic White defendants (85 out of 137 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Franklin's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% best** in Harris County. Her **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% best** in Harris County.
