## Ramona Franklin – 338<sup>th</sup> District Court

Detained:

- **82% of Black defendants (138 out of 169)**
- **64% of Hispanic White defendants (44 out of 69)**
- **63% of non-Hispanic White defendants (87 out of 139)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Ramona Franklin** detained **82% of Black defendants (138 out of 169 on an average night)**, **64% of Hispanic White defendants (44 out of 69 on an average night)**, and **63% of non-Hispanic White defendants (87 out of 139 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Franklin's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% best** in Harris County. Her **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% best** in Harris County.
