Ramona Franklin – 338th District Court

Detained:

- **78% of Black defendants (112 out of 143)**
- **61% of Hispanic White defendants (34 out of 57)**
- **60% of non-Hispanic White defendants (76 out of 127)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Ramona Franklin** detained **78% of Black defendants (112 out of 143 on an average night)**, **61% of Hispanic White defendants (34 out of 57 on an average night)**, and **60% of non-Hispanic White defendants (76 out of 127 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Franklin's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% best** in Harris County. Her **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% best** in Harris County.
