Ramona Franklin – 338th District Court

Detained:

- **80% of Black defendants (144 out of 180)**
- **64% of Hispanic White defendants (45 out of 71)**
- **61% of non-Hispanic White defendants (82 out of 135)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Ramona Franklin** detained **80% of Black defendants (144 out of 180 on an average night)**, **64% of Hispanic White defendants (45 out of 71 on an average night)**, and **61% of non-Hispanic White defendants (82 out of 135 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Franklin's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% best** in Harris County. Her **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% best** in Harris County.
