Ramona Franklin – 338th District Court

Detained:

- **81% of Black defendants (150 out of 186)**
- **62% of Hispanic White defendants (44 out of 71)**
- **61% of non-Hispanic White defendants (84 out of 138)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Ramona Franklin** detained **81% of Black defendants (150 out of 186 on an average night)**, **62% of Hispanic White defendants (44 out of 71 on an average night)**, and **61% of non-Hispanic White defendants (84 out of 138 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Franklin's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% best** in Harris County. Her **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% best** in Harris County.
