## Detained:

- 79% of Black defendants (150 out of 190)
- 62% of Hispanic White defendants (48 out of 77)
- 61% of non-Hispanic White defendants (90 out of 148)

Last week, Judge Ramona Franklin detained 79% of Black defendants (150 out of 190 on an average night), 62% of Hispanic White defendants (48 out of 77 on an average night), and 61% of non-Hispanic White defendants (90 out of 148 on an average night) in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Franklin's racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants is among the 50% best in Harris County. Her racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants is among the 25% best in Harris County.
