## Nikita Harmon – 176<sup>th</sup> District Court

Detained:

- **78% of Black defendants (136 out of 174)**
- **71% of Hispanic White defendants (41 out of 58)**
- **58% of non-Hispanic White defendants (66 out of 113)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Nikita Harmon** detained **78% of Black defendants (136 out of 174 on an average night)**, **71% of Hispanic White defendants (41 out of 58 on an average night)**, and **58% of non-Hispanic White defendants (66 out of 113 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Harmon's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% best** in Harris County. Her **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% worst** in Harris County.
