- 59% of non-Hispanic White defendants (58 out of 99)

Last week, Judge Nikita Harmon detained 76% of Black defendants (118 out of 155 on an average night), 68% of Hispanic White defendants (38 out of 56 on an average night), and 59% of non-Hispanic White defendants (58 out of 99 on an average night) in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Harmon's racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants is among the 50% best in Harris County. Her racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants is among the 50% worst in Harris County.
