## Josh Hill – 232<sup>nd</sup> District Court

Detained:

- **79% of Black defendants (103 out of 131)**
- **59% of Hispanic White defendants (32 out of 54)**
- **51% of non-Hispanic White defendants (49 out of 97)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Josh Hill** detained **79% of Black defendants (103 out of 131 on an average night)**, **59% of Hispanic White defendants (32 out of 54 on an average night)**, and **51% of non-Hispanic White defendants (49 out of 97 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Hill's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County. His **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% best** in Harris County.
