## Josh Hill – 232<sup>nd</sup> District Court

Detained:

- **78% of Black defendants (106 out of 136)**
- **62% of Hispanic White defendants (37 out of 60)**
- **49% of non-Hispanic White defendants (49 out of 99)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Josh Hill** detained **78% of Black defendants (106 out of 136 on an average night)**, **62% of Hispanic White defendants (37 out of 60 on an average night)**, and **49% of non-Hispanic White defendants (49 out of 99 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Hill's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County. His **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% worst** in Harris County.
