## Josh Hill – 232<sup>nd</sup> District Court

Detained:

- **77% of Black defendants (121 out of 158)**
- **53% of Hispanic White defendants (30 out of 57)**
- **48% of non-Hispanic White defendants (52 out of 109)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Josh Hill** detained **77% of Black defendants (121 out of 158 on an average night)**, **53% of Hispanic White defendants (30 out of 57 on an average night)**, and **48% of non-Hispanic White defendants (52 out of 109 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Hill's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County. His **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% best** in Harris County.
