## Amy Martin – 263<sup>rd</sup> District Court

Detained:

- **75% of Black defendants (89 out of 119)**
- **71% of Hispanic White defendants (35 out of 48)**
- **62% of non-Hispanic White defendants (53 out of 86)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Amy Martin** detained **75% of Black defendants (89 out of 119 on an average night)**, **71% of Hispanic White defendants (35 out of 48 on an average night)**, and **62% of non-Hispanic White defendants (53 out of 86 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Martin's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% best** in Harris County. Her **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% worst** in Harris County.
