Herb Ritchie – 337th District Court

Detained:

- **82% of Black defendants (141 out of 171)**
- **67% of Hispanic White defendants (29 out of 44)**
- **66% of non-Hispanic White defendants (64 out of 98)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Herb Ritchie** detained **82% of Black defendants (141 out of 171 on an average night)**, **67% of Hispanic White defendants (29 out of 44 on an average night)**, and **66% of non-Hispanic White defendants (64 out of 98 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Ritchie's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% best** in Harris County. His **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% best** in Harris County.
