Herb Ritchie – 337th District Court

Detained:

- **82% of Black defendants (147 out of 179)**
- **68% of Hispanic White defendants (28 out of 42)**
- **69% of non-Hispanic White defendants (66 out of 96)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Herb Ritchie** detained **82% of Black defendants (147 out of 179 on an average night)**, **68% of Hispanic White defendants (28 out of 42 on an average night)**, and **69% of non-Hispanic White defendants (66 out of 96 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Ritchie's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% best** in Harris County. His **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% best** in Harris County.
