Last week, Judge Herb Ritchie detained 81% of Black defendants (152 out of 189 on an average night), 69% of Hispanic White defendants (29 out of 42 on an average night), and 69% of non-Hispanic White defendants (68 out of 98 on an average night) in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Ritchie's racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants is among the 25% best in Harris County. His racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants is among the 25% best in Harris County.
