## Randy Roll – 179<sup>th</sup> District Court

Detained:

- **76% of Black defendants (115 out of 151)**
- **52% of Hispanic White defendants (19 out of 37)**
- **54% of non-Hispanic White defendants (54 out of 100)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Randy Roll** detained **76% of Black defendants (115 out of 151 on an average night)**, **52% of Hispanic White defendants (19 out of 37 on an average night)**, and **54% of non-Hispanic White defendants (54 out of 100 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Roll's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% worst** in Harris County. His **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% best** in Harris County.
