Randy Roll – 179th District Court

Detained:

- **78% of Black defendants (115 out of 148)**
- **62% of Hispanic White defendants (33 out of 53)**
- **54% of non-Hispanic White defendants (61 out of 113)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Randy Roll** detained **78% of Black defendants (115 out of 148 on an average night)**, **62% of Hispanic White defendants (33 out of 53 on an average night)**, and **54% of non-Hispanic White defendants (61 out of 113 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Roll's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% worst** in Harris County. His **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% worst** in Harris County.
