## Brian Warren – 209<sup>th</sup> District Court

Detained:

- **77% of Black defendants (110 out of 143)**
- **60% of Hispanic White defendants (25 out of 42)**
- **50% of non-Hispanic White defendants (51 out of 101)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, Judge Brian Warren detained 77% of Black defendants (110 out of 143 on an average night), 60% of Hispanic White defendants (25 out of 42 on an average night), and 50% of non-Hispanic White defendants (51 out of 101 on an average night) in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Warren's racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants is among the 50% worst in Harris County. His racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants is among the 50% best in Harris County.
