Brian Warren – 209th District Court

Detained:

- **81% of Black defendants (137 out of 168)**
- **63% of Hispanic White defendants (28 out of 44)**
- **51% of non-Hispanic White defendants (55 out of 108)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Brian Warren** detained **81% of Black defendants (137 out of 168 on an average night)**, **63% of Hispanic White defendants (28 out of 44 on an average night)**, and **51% of non-Hispanic White defendants (55 out of 108 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Warren's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County. His **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% worst** in Harris County.
