Brian Warren – 209th District Court

Detained:

- **82% of Black defendants (141 out of 173)**
- **59% of Hispanic White defendants (25 out of 42)**
- **53% of non-Hispanic White defendants (59 out of 111)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, **Judge Brian Warren** detained **82% of Black defendants (141 out of 173 on an average night)**, **59% of Hispanic White defendants (25 out of 42 on an average night)**, and **53% of non-Hispanic White defendants (59 out of 111 on an average night)** in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Warren's **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **25% worst** in Harris County. His **racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants** is among the **50% best** in Harris County.
