## Brian Warren – 209<sup>th</sup> District Court

Detained:

- **80% of Black defendants (150 out of 188)**
- **59% of Hispanic White defendants (28 out of 47)**
- **50% of non-Hispanic White defendants (62 out of 124)**

per night based on inability to pay

Last week, Judge Brian Warren detained 80% of Black defendants (150 out of 188 on an average night), 59% of Hispanic White defendants (28 out of 47 on an average night), and 50% of non-Hispanic White defendants (62 out of 124 on an average night) in Harris County Jail because they couldn't afford money bail.

Judge Warren's racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Black and Non-Hispanic White defendants is among the 25% worst in Harris County. His racial difference in pretrial detention rates for Hispanic and Non-Hispanic White defendants is among the 50% worst in Harris County.
